Minnesota State High School League Rules except for the following:

1. All games will be 15 minute halves (running time) except for the final minute of each half.
2. No Zone Defense. Press during last minute of game only.
3. No pressing if a team is leading by 15 or more points.
4. 2 time outs per game. (45 seconds in length)
5. 3 minute half times.
6. Overtime will be 2 minutes (stopped time the last minute only)
7. Technical Fouls-automatic 2 points plus the ball
